PROGRAM GOALS

NURSE WELL-BEING: BUILDING PEER AND LEADERSHIP SUPPORT



- Utilizes the Stress First Aid (SFA) Model, a framework that focuses on using peer support to improve recovery from stress reactions, both in oneself and in coworkers.
- In partnership with four pilot sites, the American Nurses Foundation adapted SFA into a learning curriculum tailored to nurses.
- Pilots: BayCare Health (also ANCC Well-Being Excellence pilot), USA Health University Hospital, Indiana University Health, and Atrium Health Wake Forest Baptist.
- Program creates a shared language around stress and burnout to lessen the stigma nurses may encounter when in need of help and create a culture of well-being.
- Program curriculum is now available for free on the American Nurses Enterprise Learning Management System.

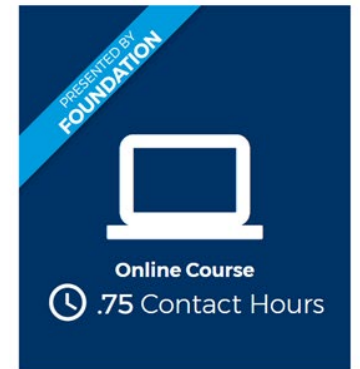
